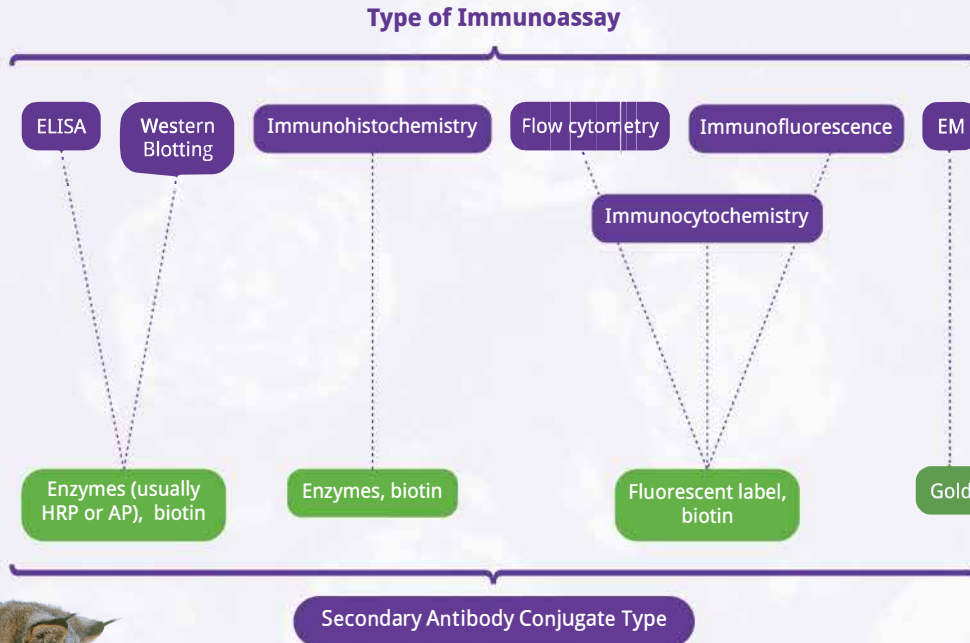




Types of secondary labels for different immunoassays



Use a secondary antibody, pre-adsorbed with serum, for western blotting. Ideal also for immunohistochemistry and multi-color imaging where multiple primaries and corresponding secondaries are used.

For IHC, the secondary antibody should be pre-adsorbed against the same species as the sample on which the detection is performed.

Use affinity purified antibodies to give the lowest amount of non-specific binding whereas IgG fractions contain high affinity antibodies.
